ACTION PLAN

- 1) Read the Civilian and DoD documents even if you are only under DoD authority. The civilian document provides a significant educational background. They are located @ <https://covidpenalty.com/leader/>
- 2) Set it in your heart to contact the priority list and, should time allow, the secondary list. However, both lists are important, and each call you make adds to our success rate. Regardless of your residency, you can call each person on the list. Our #1 priority is to call all of the state attorneys general.
- 3) The average call time will last about 2 minutes. You are not calling to tell your story. If you press ahead and tell each person on the phone your story, it will have a negative effect after 1,500 other callers do the same thing.
- 4) The goal is to ensure the intended person we're calling takes time to read the document so they can act for our benefit. The documents have taken hundreds of hours of research and will produce fruit when others consider them carefully.
- 5) Read the script as a guide. It would help if you took the time to modify it to suit your personality. However, your goal is to give your speech in under 60 seconds for each call.
- 6) Take time to reach out to others under mandate duress and request they participate. I would love nothing more than 5,000 people calling!
- 7) Consider financially supporting Brian, who has given his time freely to attorneys, leaders, and others to end the COVID-19 assault on our liberties.
- 8) The contacts were chosen based on the absolute belief they will act once they become educated of the facts.

SCRIPT:

I am using a fictitious name and organization to be replaced by you:

My name is Curly Sue, and I would like to leave a message for Attorney General O’Conner. (They will typically say, “ok, what message would you like to leave?”) I would like for Attorney General O’Conner to visit the website CovidPenalty.Com and click on the “leader” link to access a policy paper proving that the Veterans Administration is not allowed to penalize me for refusing a COVID-19 experimental vaccine. It is very important to me that Mr. O’Conner reads this document because it reveals statutes passed by Congress that our elected leaders are unaware of. Those statutes provide me the right to refuse those vaccines without incurring a penalty. (Then the receptionist will ask for your name etc.) NOTE: Do not request a callback. If 1,500 people leave a message requesting the person to read a document with no callback required, they will read it.

A state attorney general can accomplish in one week what it will take a civilian attorney to accomplish in six months. This is a worthy effort for a quick resolution.
